




Severe Weather Response

- Courtesy Team (CT)
 - CT will monitor when severe weather is possible.
 - When the evacuation to shelter notice is given, the CT will help direct people to the lower level and to appropriate shelter.
 - See next slide for CT posts.





General

Movement of People

- Group leaders should help to assure parents that their children are being taken to shelter and that they should not attempt to go to their children's classrooms.
- People should move calmly to lower level and as far down hallways as possible; fill in rooms before halls.
- Do not remain in stairwells for shelter.






- Movement of People
 - Special **Saturday** Note:
 - During worship service and when a severe weather watch is in effect, the Pollock/Mercer and Fox community groups will sit in the back of the worship center. When the call for evacuation to shelter is made, they will go to the Toddler area, Rooms 207 – 217, to assist with taking babies and toddlers to shelter.







- Movement of People (continued)
 - After everyone is downstairs, stairwell doors should be closed.
 - People should remain in their assigned shelter locations until READY TO RETURN TO AREA is announced.
















Severe Weather Response

- Building A Lower Level
 - Stay in classrooms except for the Forum, Library and K- 2 Suite.
 - Forum and Library move to Room A135 and gather in the West corner.
 - **K-2 Suite** move to GAP Room.



Severe Weather Response

- Building B Lower Level (cont)
 - Gymnasium move across the hall to Student Rec Center and gather along N and E walls (as far into room as possible)
 - **Cafe** move to **Kid's Connection** SW corner
 - Kid's Connection remain in NW or NE corner
