c. How does this truth apply to a specific area(s) of my life? (marriage, children, work, friendships, ministry, personal devotion)

d. How do I remember this truth & its application?

II. Remember it is a dialogue...

- a. Prayer is just as integral as our study of God's Word, because it is through prayer that God makes the truths of His Word become real in our lives.
- b. The purpose of prayer
 - i. To grow in our trust in and dependence on God
 - ii. To have deeper fellowship with God
 - iii. To be a part of God's Kingdom work

PART 3: Connecting to a Christian Community
