## Discussion Guide: Week 1

Jeremiah 1:1-10, Psalm 139:13-14	You Are More Unique Than You Think

- 1. What do you think it means to be unique? Do you think most people believe that they are unique? Why do you think that?
- 2. How does God tell Jeremiah in this passage that he is unique? What is Jeremiah's objection to God's thoughts about his uniqueness? What doubts or objections do you tend to believe about yourself?
- 3. What does Jeremiah's unique design have to do with his unique destiny? On a scale of 1 to 5, how easy is it to believe that you have a unique destiny, as Jeremiah did?
- 4. If your life was an utterly unique creation of God, how would you know? If somebody was looking at your life from the outside, would they say you are living it uniquely? Why do you think that?
- 5. In the sermon, we heard that really knowing your design is like experiencing the totality of a solar eclipse. How do you think your life would be different if you experienced the totality of knowing the true you? What barriers might keep you from experiencing totality? What might you have to do differently to take a step toward totality over the next several weeks?
